

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 34 OF ORDINANCE NO. 16 OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE KNOWN AS THE "ORDINANCE FOR THE GOVERNMENT AND OPERATION OF THE WATERWORKS OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE", ADOPTED OCTOBER 18, 1968, AMENDING THE MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE FOR WATER RECEICED

SECTION 34: The rates for water furnished to customers by the waterworks shall be as follows: The rate for water shall be one dollar (\$1.00) per one thousand (1,000) gallons of water per month, with a minimum monthly charge of one dollar (\$1.00) per month. The minimum monthly rate shall be paid where the water meter is not presently installed, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that all premises receiving water from the waterworks must have approved meters installed not later than June 30, 1971.

AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 34: The rates for water furnished to customers by the waterworks shall be as follows: The rate for water shall be one dollar (\$1.00) per one thousand (1,000) gallons of water per month, with a minimum monthly charge of five dollars (\$5.00) per month. The minimum monthly rate shall be paid where the water meter is not presently installed. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that all premises receiving water from the waterworks must have approved meters installed not later than March 31, 1972.
