

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13 OF ORDINANCE NO. 16 OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE KNOWN AS THE "ORDINANCE FOR THE GOVERNMENT AND OPERATION OF THE WATERWORKS OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE", ADOPTED OCTOBER 18, 1968, AMENDING THE TAP IN FEE.

SECTION 13: No person except an authorized employee of the waterworks shall tap any main or distributing pipe. Service connections shall be installed by the Borough from the street main to the curb on line of the same, including stop cock and box, and shall be charged to the owner of the property with which the connection is made at the following rates:

3/4 inch opening in main, 3/4 inch pipe, 3/4 inch stop cock and box \$45.00

1 inch opening in main, 1 inch pipe, 1 inch stop cock and box \$50.00

AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 13: No person except an authorized employee of the waterworks shall tap any main or distributing pipe. Service connections shall be installed by the Borough from the street main to the curb on line of the same, including stop cock and box and water meter and remote reader, and shall be charged to the owner of the property with which the connection is made at the following rates:

3/4 inch opening in main, 3/4 inch pipe, 3/4 inch stop cock and box and water meter and remote reader \$100.00
