

ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE,
SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE
ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH REGULATING THE
USE AND ENJOYMENT FOR RECREATIONAL AND
OTHER PURPOSES OF INDIAN LAKE.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Indian Lake has by Ordinance No. 82 restated in its entirety all of the prior Boating Ordinances and Amendments thereto regulating the use and enjoyment for recreation and other purposes of Indian Lake; and

WHEREAS, the Borough believes it to be in the best interest of the residents of the Borough and the community itself to modify the Ordinance as stated;

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Borough of Indian Lake as follows:

ARTICLE I: Article One - Licensing and Regulation of Boating in General, Section 101 Type: is hereby amended by adding the the following language to the end of the second sentence of the Section, to wit: "and all powered vessels must have exhaust systems which vent the exhaust below the water line of the vessel while at rest." That sentence shall hereinafter read, "No boat or vessel regardless of length, shall be used or operated upon the waters of Indian Lake, unless the mode of power of said boat is manual, sail, or by outboard, inboard-outboard stern drive motor or inboard motor, not exceeding a total or combined horsepower of 265, and all powered vessels must have exhaust systems which vent the exhaust below the water line of the vessel while at rest."

ARTICLE II: Article One - Licensing and Regulation of Boating in General.
Section 102., Boat Licenses; Sub-Section E - Commercial Rental Licenses.
Sub-Section 2 - Indian Lake Marina; Sub-Section B: - Nonpowered
Watercraft is hereby amended by deleting the language "No licenses" and inserting
therefor "Five (5) Licenses".

ARTICLE III: The remainder of Ordinance No. 82 is hereby ratified in its
entirety.

ARTICLE IV. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately from the date and
time of enactment hereof.
